

Drum Clamps

Drum Clamp - Forklifts are used to deal with moving, lifting and storing pallets. For companies which handle products inside drums, you will need to utilize an attachment to be able to lift, store and move them. There are various drum forklift accessories that you could obtain for all your drum moving, lifting and storing needs. These attachments are specially utilized in order to handle drum containers - therefore there is no risk of damage to the product or drum container when they are stored, moved or lifted.

Drum Positioner And Grab

The drum positioner could be used to load and unload drums off of drum stands, vehicles and racks. These are obtainable in three or four tine models. This accessory is completely automatic, hence allowing the operator to be able to operate all from the comfort of the lift truck seat. Able to move large and extra large plastic drums, steel, its capacity is 210 liters. This particular attachment is intended for drum pyramid stacking.

The drum grab can be mounted to the forks, with a designed objective of handling metal drums which have rolling hoops. Though the original reason for the design was to deal with steel drums with rolling hoops, the drum grab could help accommodate plastic drums as well. Drum capacity maximum is 220 liters for plastic barrels and 210 for steel drums with rolling hoops.

The Rotator

The drum rotator is one more lift truck attachment which mounts onto the forks themselves. Their objective is to be able to pick up the drum and turn it upside down. The drum is clasped into the drum rotator with a clamp that fits around the middle of the drum. The rotation is done by either a crank handle or a continuous loop chain. The crank handle is utilized for operations which take place below shoulder level. For operations that must occur over shoulder level, the continuous circle chain will be used.

Drum tines are straightforward fork mounted attachment which can be intended for unstacking or stacking 210-liter steel drums. Stacking requires nothing fancy, merely easy horizontal placement of the drums. The carriage-mounted accessories lessen the load center of the drums.

Automatic Tongs

Drum tongs are available both semi-automatic and automatic models that can be utilized in the tight head and open topped steel drum styles. The drum tongs can likewise be attached in many different ways to the lift truck. One way is to connect them under a fork-mounted hook. Another way is to connect them to a carriage mounted jib or a fork-mounted jib. Either the automatic and semi-automatic have a drum capacity of 210 liters. With the automatic, there is no need for the operator to ever leave the seat of the lift truck.

Rim Grip Handler

The Rip Grip Drum Handler is the ideal choice for forklift accessories, whenever there is a need to store drums with inadequate space obtainable. This accessory could be utilized on both 120L and 210L drums. The Rim Grip Handler works by utilizing metal jaws so as to grab the rim of the drum. It lifts the drum and puts it down without requiring any room between all the drums. The typical unit utilized in the business is a zinc-plated handler, though, this particular accessory is available in stainless steel for the food and drink industry.
