The 4 Main Kinds of Floor Scrubber

2. Mains & Battery Operated

Mains operated ground scrubbers are a lot more common than the battery operated model, yet the battery operated type is perfect for locations with restricted utility sockets or sockets are too far from work area and extended power options are not accessible. The battery operated version is best suited for small places like washrooms with hard to reach areas which would be difficult to clean with a trailing power lead. The battery could be charged and used for around 4 hours previous to re-charging is required. The battery could even be replaced if necessary.

3. Ride-on or Walking devices
